MISSION:

The Grant Foresight Scholarship Award (GFSA) was created to promote higher possibilities for Black/African American students in their endeavors. Consistent with the ideals of the Grant Family, the Scholarship Fund will encourage more Black/African American youth to purposefully consider their passion in education, trade, or business. This award was birthed as a rich scholastic, athletic and philanthropic legacy of the 3 high honor Grant scholars who are now proud alumni of Newburgh Free Academy (NFA) – Class of 2018, Class of 2021 and Class of 2022.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM CRITERIA:

Welcome to the Grant Foresight Scholarship Award (GFSA) for African-American students pursuing college degrees, trade, or requiring capital towards a business. An individual is eligible for a one-time scholarship/capital investment for education, business-related expenses if he/she/they meets the established criteria.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS MUST:

- Be a Black/African-American student – NFA graduating senior and submit a headshot photo of yourself (2”x2”).
- Have achieved a minimum of 3.0 GPA and submit a high school transcript including Fall 2021 grades.
- Use the scholarship towards an accredited college or university, trade or vocational school.
 - If attending a university or college and becomes recipient, then present verification of enrollment from the institution registrar's office before payment is granted.
 - If application requires the scholarship to business related expenses, then submit a brief business plan.
- Demonstrate a commitment to serving the Newburgh community.
- Participate in a GFSA interview process (Finalists ONLY).

NOTE: GFSA recipient must submit a statement on the value of receiving and giving.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:

The scholarship will be in the amount of \$1000 awarded directly to the recipient interviewed and selected by the Grant Family. Judging will be based on academic achievements, extracurricular and community activities, essay, etc. The completed application must be forwarded in an electronic format to GrantForesight@gmail.com by Friday, April 8, 2022 | 11:59pm EST. All materials/supporting documentation must be included with the application in order to be considered. Late and incomplete applications will not be accepted. No exceptions will be made.
